KUALA LUMPUR: A consortium comprising Salcon Bhd and KAB Smart Solar Energy Sdn Bhd (KSSE) has been selected as one of the Corporate Green Power Programme (CGPP) solar power producers.

Kinergy Advancement Bhd (KAB) said in a fil-ing with Bursa Malaysia yesterday the consortium had an export capacity allotment of seven MWac in Sungai Siput, Perak.

Presently, 563.42
MWac have been awarded to 22 applicants, with another 236.58 MWac yet to be assigned.

KSSE is a wholly-owned subsidiary of KAB.
