SALCON Bhd has secured a RM80.4 million water infrastructure contract in Penang via its wholly owned unit Salcon Engineering Bhd.

The group said the contract was awarded by Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd and involves the design, supply, installation and testing of a treated water pipeline linking the proposed Sungai Kerian Water Treatment Plant to the Batu Kawan Reservoir, with provision for future connection to the Jawi Reservoir.

“This award reinforces our commitment to supporting sustainable water supply development through reliable and efficient engineering solutions with a strong focus on safety and operational excellence. We look forward to delivering this and contributing to the long-term resilience of water infrastructure in Pulau Pinang,” Salcon Engineering CEO Jamiluddin Amini Sulaiman said.

The project will run for 36 months from April 6, 2026, and is slated for completion by April 5, 2029.

It is expected to contribute positively to Salcon’s earnings and net assets from the financial year ending Dec 31, 2026 onwards. — **TMR**
